The Philip Gottschalk Collection contains research materials for his publication *In Deadly Earnest* and multiple versions of the original manuscript.

The collection was donated to the University of Missouri by Philip Gottschalk on 16 May 1995 (Accession No. 5525).

RESTRICTIONS

The materials are open for research, but the Civil War documents may not be photocopied.

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Philip Gottschalk was born December 23, 1920, in Detroit. After the death of his parents, he moved to Jefferson City, Missouri, to be raised by relatives. He served in World War II and after the war became a newspaper man in Nebraska. He was an accomplished journalist who worked for the *Columbia Tribune* until January 1986 when he retired. Gottschalk was a Civil War history buff and loved to reference Civil War history in everyday life. He wrote a book called *In Deadly Earnest* which described the activities of Confederate troops in Missouri and the impact they had on the Civil War. Phil passed away February 12, 2000.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection has been arranged into the following three series:

Research Manuscripts WWII

The **Research** series contains photocopied or transcribed diary pages and information on officers and a few enlisted soldiers from the Confederate Missouri Brigade.

The **Manuscript** series consists of material pertaining to the writing and publishing of *In Deadly Earnest*.

The **WWII** series consists of one folder containing Gottschalk's work in the Program Surveys Division of the Department of Agriculture and contains interview questions, transcripts of interviews, and correspondence regarding the work conducted in that program in 1942.
