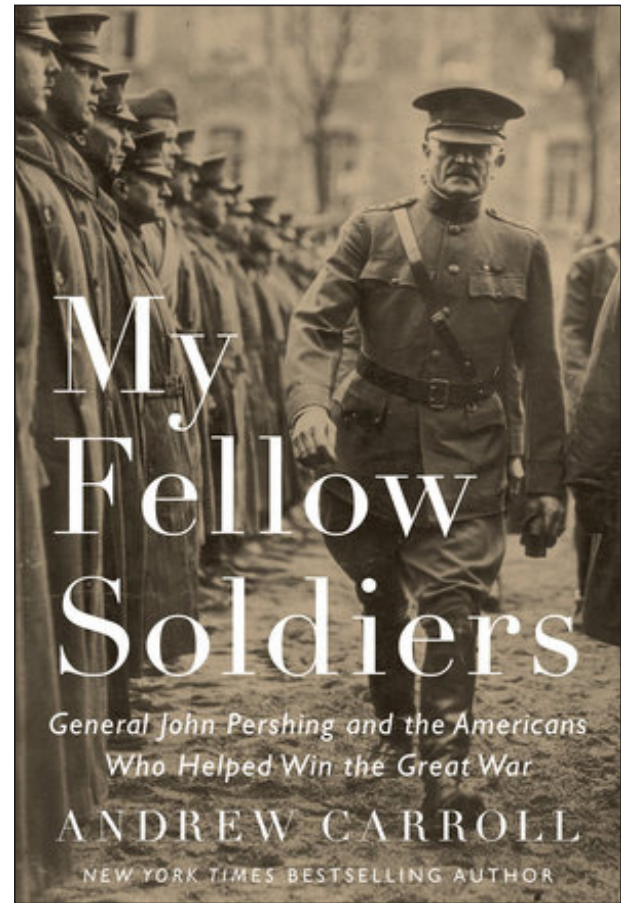

**Program** After four years of fighting and 36 million casualties, a Missourian helped end the Great War. The American Expeditionary Forces led by General John J. Pershing cut through German lines in the fall of 1918 and changed the course of the First World War. 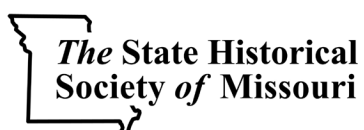
