#### INTRODUCTION

Papers and letters of Brig. Gen. John H. Holman. Holman was a colonel during the Civil War, and was one of the first men to command colored troops in the war. In 1865 he was promoted to the rank of Brig. Gen of Volunteers. Papers include correspondence regarding his command; a map of the "Seat of War"; two Sam Grant letters; one John C. Fremont letter; official documents: discharges, promotions, and ordinance reports; and personal letters.
