INTRODUCTION

To Beverly [Thompson], [Arrow Rock, MO], from Boonville, [MO], Nov. 1, 1864.

Horror of war in Missouri, "a bone of contention." Fire destroyed a block on Main Street in Boonville. General Price camped in Boonville, stripped town and country of cattle, forage, and staple goods. Best citizens have fled, friends joining both armies. Family information.
