BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Eugene Robinett, son of Oliver Lee and Nellie (Reese) Robinett, was born in Mansfield, Missouri, on March 19, 1918. He graduated from the University of Missouri in 1940. After graduation he enlisted in the Marine Corps and served with the Third Division in New Zealand and the Pacific from 1943-1945. He went through the war without injury only to lose his life in an automobile accident on October 28, 1945.
