INTRODUCTION

The papers of a journalist, author, and editorial writer for the *Los Angeles Times* include news articles, story files, books, manuscripts, research files, correspondence, personal papers, and interviews on audio cassette.

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Mary Katherine (Kay) Mills was born on February 4, 1941, to Morris H. and Mary S. Mills in Washington, D.C. She graduated from Bethesda-Chevy Chase Senior High School in 1959 and went on to attend Pennsylvania State University where she received a B.A. in political science in 1963. While at Penn State she worked on the school's newspaper, the *Daily Collegian*. She received an M.A. in African history from Northwestern University in 1965.

After graduating from Northwestern, Kay Mills began her career in journalism with United Press International in Chicago, working as a broadcast news writer. She then moved to the *Baltimore Evening Sun*, where she covered education and child welfare issues, topics that would continue to interest her throughout her career. Mills briefly worked as assistant press secretary for U.S. Senator Edmund S. Muskie from 1970 to 1971, before joining the Washington bureau of the Newhouse News Service. At Newhouse she covered federal regulatory agencies and women in politics.

In 1978, Mills moved to California to become an editorial writer for the *Los Angeles Times* and later an assistant editor of the newspaper's Sunday Opinion section. During the mid-1980s, Mills became involved with a new professional organization, the Journalism and Women Symposium (JAWS). She served as a member of the first board of directors, and edited the group's newsletter off and on for many years.

Mills published her first book in 1988, the groundbreaking *A Place in the News: From the Women's Pages to the Front Page*. Three years later, Mills left the *Times* to pursue writing and freelance work full-time. Published in 1993, her next book was the critically acclaimed *This Little Light of Mine: The Life of Fannie Lou Hamer*, winner of the 1993 Christopher Award and the 1993-94 Julia Spruill Prize for the best book on Southern women's history. During the 1990s, she also wrote a general interest book on women's history (*From Pocahontas to Power Suits: Everything You Need to Know About*

Women's History in America, 1995) and a book on Head Start (*Something Better for My Children: The History and People of Head Start*, 1998).

As a freelancer, Mills wrote for a variety of publications, including, *The New York Times*, the *Dallas Morning News*, the *St. Louis Post-Dispatch*, *Ms.*, *Mother Jones*, the *Columbia Journalism Review*, *Governing*, and *The Progressive*. Beginning in 2001, Mills wrote a series of education articles for *National Crosstalk*.

In 2004, Mills published her final book, *Changing Channels: The Civil Rights Case That Transformed Television*. She was at work on a mystery novel when she died in Santa Monica, California, from a heart attack on January 13, 2011. Mills was 69.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Kay Mills Papers have been arranged into the following nine series: **Articles**; **Story Files**; **Books and Manuscripts**; **Correspondence**; **Professional**; **Personal**; **Family**; **Photographs**; and **Audiovisual**.

The **Articles** series contains articles written by Mills throughout her journalistic career at the *Baltimore Sun*, Newhouse News Service, the *Los Angeles Times*, and as a freelancer. The series also includes academic articles published by Mills and a scrapbook containing articles written for UPI and Penn State's *Daily Collegian*.

The **Story Files** series includes article drafts, notes, correspondence, and research material for stories written by Kay Mills. The bulk of the material pertains to articles Mills wrote for the *Los Angeles Times* and *National Crosstalk*.

The **Books and Manuscripts** series is comprised of manuscript drafts, research material, correspondence, and related material for books and manuscripts written by Kay Mills, including *Changing Channels: The Civil Rights Case That Transformed Television*, *A Place in the News: From the Women's Pages to the Front Page*, and *This Little Light of Mine: The Life of Fannie Lou Hamer*.

The series also includes an unpublished manuscript entitled, "A Sister's Devotion," concerning letters written by her mother's cousin, Lucy Lee Lancaster, to her ill sister, Martha Lancaster, in 1925-1926 while Lucy was attending the New York State Library School in Albany. Copies of the letters from Lucy to Martha are also included.

The **Correspondence** series contains both personal and professional correspondence of Kay Mills, including letters from readers and correspondence with George F. Will regarding the Equal Rights Amendment. Also included are Mills's annual Christmas/New Year's letters and correspondence between Mills and women she sponsored through Women for Women International.

The **Professional** series consists of material pertaining to Mills's professional endeavors, including fellowships, consulting work, and teaching journalism classes, as well as her involvement in the Journalism and Women Symposium. The series also includes speeches, resumes, and reporter's notebooks.

The **Personal** series includes journals, appointment calendars, yearbooks, and school material. Writing almost daily, Mills kept detailed journals from 1983 to 1990. She also kept travel journals during the late 2000s, writing about trips to Greece, France, and Moldova. Of note, are two school essays written by Mills in the mid-1950s: "Scheherezade Speaks, Or, The 4851 Nights" and "Women's Rights." The series also includes a disbound scrapbook from friends and colleagues when Mills moved to California in 1978 to begin working at the *Los Angeles Times*.

The **Family** series contains material concerning Mills's parents, Morris H. and Mary S. Mills, including the diaries of Mary S. Mills, which she kept from 1959 until her death in 1999.

The **Photographs** series includes photographs of Mills taken throughout her life, as well as two family photographs dated circa 1890s-1900s. Many of the 1950s photographs show Mills's friends in junior high and high school. Also included in the series is a disbound photo album concerning the early years of the Journalism and Women Symposium, with numerous photographs of Mills and other women journalists hiking and enjoying the outdoors at the group's annual fall camps. Photographs of Mills's parents can be found at the end of the series.

The **Audiovisual** series largely contains audio cassettes with interviews conducted by Kay Mills. The interviews are loosely arranged alphabetically as some of the audio cassettes contain interviews with more than one individual. Also included in this series are speeches and radio interviews given by Kay Mills concerning her books, as well as recordings she likely used in her research for articles and books. These materials are arranged chronologically by format.
