This is a certificate for 1000 shares of stock in the United-Mexican Mines Company, which was incorporated in Arizona but had corporate offices at Kansas City in Jackson County, Missouri. The shares were purchased by Fred Crosby, who was also the Secretary of the firm.

The United-Mexican Mines Company had an announced capitalization of \$5,000,000. This certificate (No. 1543) is for 1000 shares at one dollar each. The certificate is dated 5 May 1913 and was issued to Fred Crosby. It is signed by Crosby as Secretary of the company, and by the firm's Vice President, W. A. Willis.
