This is a certificate for 300 shares of stock in the Plattin Valley Mining Company of St. Louis, Missouri. The certificate was issued to Charles Brockhoff on 23 May 1907 and was signed by Dr. Henry F. Bartens, President, and Alexander J. Bartens, Secretary.

According to Articles of Association on file with the Missouri Secretary of State, the Plattin Valley Mining Company was organized on 23 February 1907. Principals were Dr. Henry F. Bartens (98,900 shares), Ernst John (98,900 shares), William H. Demler (1000 shares), Samuel Neier (1000 shares), and Alexander J. Bartens (200 shares), all of St. Louis, Missouri. The firm received state charter #20900 on 26 February 1907. Capitalization was \$200,000 distributed among 200,000 shares of stock. Presumably the intent of the corporation was to develop a mining industry in the Plattin Creek valley in Jefferson County, Missouri, just south of St. Louis. Henry F. Bartens was an 1876 alumnus of the Homeopathic Medical College of Missouri.

This certificate #36 for 300 shares was issued to Charles Brockhoff on 23 May 1907. It was signed by Dr. Henry F. Bartens, President, and Alexander J. Bartens, Secretary.

According to an "Affidavit for Dissolution" filed with the Missouri Secretary of State by President William Demler on 24 December 1912, the company's directors had voted unanimously to dissolve the corporation on 29 January 1912.
